On June 2 I flew to High Point to work with the other members of the Scholarship Selection Committee to select the winners of this year's therapy scholarships. While the money available was not as great as last year's the committee did select 210 recipients and the Therapist of the Year winner. There were almost 400 club-sponsored applicants as well as several hundred non-club sponsored applicants who had completed the application process. (There were also more than 200 hundred individuals who submitted incomplete applications). In addition to these scholarship applications, there were 17 nominees for the Therapist of the Year Award.

Greenebucs sponsored 18 students; 3 of those were incomplete applications. Of the remaining 15, 4 received \$500 scholarships and I was awarded a William L. White Scholarship of \$1000. (Since the winners have not as yet been notified, their names will be listed in the next newsletter).

While this selection process was long and tedious, the one for Therapist of the year was more challenging! All 17 applicants were outstanding but **Joyce Peet** was the unanimous choice of the committee a member of our own Greenebucs Club.

Besides selecting the winners of these awards, I was also the first person from Greenebucs to get to see the new headquarters. It is wonderful! The spaciousness of the building, the openness of the interior layout and the exterior capacity for expansion shows a lot of forethought and planning that preceded the actual construction. By the time of the national convention, the landscaping and the brick courtyard should be in place. If you are planning on attending the convention, I am sure you will be pleased with the final outcome. If you cannot attend, I am sure we will come back with lots of pictures.
