K.I.D.S. Identification Project

The K.I.D.S. Identification Program is a significant part of the Community Outreach Division of the Greene County Prosecutor's office.

The purpose of the program is to provide parents with a means to assist in locating their children in the unlikely event they become missing or are abducted.

A free laminated identification card, complete with the child's photograph, thumbprint, and identifying information is printed out and given to parents who wish to participate. This card can be taken to any local police department to assist in a search should one become necessary.

The K.I.D.S. trailer is highly visible and is at every Greene County festival during the spring, summer, and fall months.

During the winter months, the program is taken to all branches of the Greene County Library and plans are underway for expansion to other locations in the county during the winter of 2008/2009.
