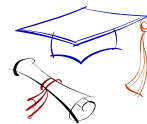

## SCHOLARSHIP REPORT



The Scholarship winners for the 2011-2012 school year were recently announced by the national AM-BUCS office. This year 281 students shared more than \$ 183,000.00. That is a significant increase over the dollar amount given last year. All the recipients are students in the fields of Hearing, Speech, Occupational and/or Physical therapies, are full time students and have completed at least 2 years of study. This year Greenebucs sponsored 19 students. Of those, 12 were selected as recipients and shared in \$9500.00. Rosie McAuley and Katelyn Howenstine, winners from last year and residents of Fairborn and Beavercreek respectively, were again selected. Both these young ladies have attended Greenebucs meetins and spoke of the benefit they gained by receiving these awards. Scholarship applications will open again in January 2012, so if you know any students who are studying in these fields, please inform them of this program.

Tuesday, June 14, 2011 was a beautiful weather day in Ohio for the second annual "Cast for Kids" fishing derby. With 60 participants from all over the Miami Valley area, children and adults with special needs fished with their families and siblings at Rainbow Lakes in Fairborn.

This event requires an all encompassing coordination of the community to provide a volunteer for each individual. Forty military personnel from Wright Patterson Air Force Base volunteered and chose a family to assist making sure they had a great time. From putting on the bait (yes squirmy worms), to instructing the individuals on casting their line out, to taking the fish off the lines, volunteers and participants enjoyed the fishing and fun.

There were many contributors to this event. The Ohio Division of Wildlife, Greene County Board of Developmental Disabilities, Gander Mountain and GreeneBucs donated funds to cover the cost of sponsoring a child/adult; each received a fishing pole, tackle box, plaque with their picture and a t-shirt. The major sponsor was the Modern Woodsman Fraternal Financial Group, who matched funds raised from the above sponsors. Behind the scenes were ladies collecting donations from the Lady Fingers Nail Salon, funds for the beverages and food were raised through bake sales held at Rainbow Lakes, the Old Fashion Rod & Gun club, local Lodges 1063 and 73.
